

# TROOP 67 CAMPING CHECKLIST

(remember the Scout Motto: Be Prepared)

## REQUIRED \*

- PERMISSION SLIP TO GO ON CAMPOUT
- FRIDAY LUNCH & SUNDAY LUNCH MONEY
- HIKING BOOTS (not tennis shoes)
- PERSONAL HYGIENE KIT (towel, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, comb, soap or hand sanitizer, and toilet paper)
- SCOUT UNIFORM
- BACKPACK (internal or external, if you have one)
- POCKETKNIFE (only for Scouts with Totin Chip)
- A CHANGE OF "CIVILIAN" WEATHER-RELATED CLOTHING FOR EACH DAY OF CAMP (**HEAD-TO-TOE, INSIDE AND OUT IF DURING COOLER WEATHER SEASON**)
- RAIN GEAR (Poncho or rain coat -- even if it's not raining the day we leave -- preferably made of a "breathable" material)
- WATER BOTTLE
- FLASHLIGHT AND EXTRA BATTERIES
- SUN BLOCK (take this even on cloudy days)
- COMPASS (models from, or similar to those available at, the Scout Shop)
- GROUND CLOTH (5' X 7' or 7' X 7')
- SLEEPING BAG (with a temperature rating of at least 20° F is suggested)
- MESS KIT (Frisbee, spoon, cup)
- FIRST AID KIT (see Boy Scout Handbook)
- BOY SCOUT HANDBOOK
- NOTEBOOK AND PENCIL/PEN

## OPTIONAL

- WATCH
- CAMERA AND FILM (only inexpensive types)
- SUNGLASSES
- SMALL MUSICAL INSTRUMENT
- SWIMSUIT (not cut-offs)
- BIBLE / RELIGIOUS READING MATERIAL
- FISHING GEAR
- ALARM CLOCK
- LIP BALM (such as Chap Stick®)
- INSECT REPELLENT
- SPENDING MONEY
- CLOTHING REPAIR KIT (needle & thread)
- HIKING SOCKS (we do a lot of hiking/walking on our campouts, these can make life a lot easier)
- SECOND PAIR OF SHOES (like Tennis Shoes to change into when around campsite, not to be used on a hike or to replace hiking boots)
